

Knowing how to use these elements to create paintings is essential to well designed paintings. Learn to create a painting, not copy a photograph.

You will also learn to get more exciting results from your watercolor paint through exercises that teach you the correct paint to water ratio for the subject you want to paint. You will learn different brush techniques that will allow the watercolor paint to be more expressive and fresh on your paper.

Martha will show you how to approach your watercolor paintings with more confidence by simplifying your subject in order to make a stronger statement.

Finally, you will learn how to plan your painting prior to putting paint on the paper, thus helping you to make fewer bad choices that result in your having to figure out how to save the painting.

Lastly, Martha uses four unusual Holbein colors in her paintings: Grey of Greys, Juane Brilliant, Compose Green and Verditer Blue. She will incorporate these colors in her demonstration paintings and show you how these colors can create exciting results in your paintings also.
